Contest Registration: All Sections

- 2. Bands may play no more than 30 Brass players on stage.
- 3. All bands must submit a list of players expected to perform on the day, by the deadline of March 11th.

At least 20 of the players must be registered with the band they wish to play for, with Brass Band Players Ltd. Registration cards will be required on the day for the 20 representatives per band.

The following list may change up to **March 25th, 2024**, however 20 registered representatives are still required.

- 4. Replacement spaces are to be used between **March 25th** and **April 6th**. ConsTest must be notified of these changes as soon as possible.
- 5. Replacement players, or players not included in the 20 registered players, may be from any section.
- 6. Replacement players may also replace Registered players.
- 7. Bands may borrow, up to, two players from the previous band if needed.
- 8. Two on-the-day emergency replacements are permitted, should ConsTest be notified (via email) at least 1 hour before the scheduled performance.
- 9. Any replacement players or emergency players may play for up to 2 bands on the contest day.
- 10. Please tick the boxes of the 20(+) players that will provide registration cards on the day.
- 11. Registered players names must match that of their registration cards.
- 12. The contest will be pre-drawn, on **February 16th, 2024**.
- 13. Please leave the final column empty, this is for the contest control team on the day of the contest.
